PROGRAM INFORMATION: For Boys and Girls entering Grades 4-7 in the Fall of 2017.

'Back to School'- The 2017 School Year will be extended this year with our 6th installment of the Kids @ Cobbler Shop Program. This unique Program offers activities that appeal to many interests including Nature, Crafts, Games, Music, Cooking, Acting and Academics all within the confines of a Historic Time period. At this year's Kids @ Cobbler Shop your children will explore Life in Sherman during the 19th Century with a particular focus on the six original District Schoolhouses that once existed in our town. That's right.... six Schoolhouses! Hoag, Edmonds, Center, Leach Hollow, Briggs and Coburn. Each of the kids will be assigned to one of the 6 Schoolhouses and will be given a name and a brief bio of a child who attended school in Sherman during that time period. The children will personify their historical characters throughout the week with the culmination of the 'Schoolhouse skits' on Friday June 30th (Families are welcome to attend). History will be brought back to life as the historic family names Hungerford, Briggs, Wakeman, Northrop, Pepper, Wanzer, Evans and Hoag ring out in Cobbler Field as the children 'Ring the Bell' each day at our historic Schoolhouse exhibit. But don't worry, Kids @ Cobbler Shop is not just about school and history lessons! We have MANY fun activities planned for the kids and hope they can join us for an unforgettable week.
